This contract is for all supply, delivery and assembly of material necessary for the above-referenced project at Facility No. 1, 3445 St. Lawrence Drive, Toledo, OH 43605, in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, for the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority at One Maritime Plaza, Toledo, OH 43604.

Bids will be received at the Port Authority's administrative offices at One Maritime Plaza, Toledo, OH 43604 until Monday July 13, 2009, at 4:00 PM, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The delivery address is 3445 St. Lawrence Drive, Toledo, OH 43605. The project consists of furnishing, delivering and assembling two (2) four- (4) rope tire mounted mobile harbor cranes, which are: (1) suitable to handle cargo to/from Panamax-size vessels of 105 ft. beam; (2) suitable for handling bulk materials, break-bulk/general cargo and 20/40/45 foot containers; (3) designed to impart the lowest possible loads on the dock; (4) capable of climbing a maximum of 5% grade during travel; (5) feature level luffing; and (6) supported on outrigger pads during cargo handling operations. Major machinery and electrical control equipment must be located within weather-proof enclosures in the lower portion of the superstructure. The cranes must be capable of simultaneous and independent operations of slewing, main hoist, and boom hoist motions under full load and speed, and must have a lifting capacity of 80 metric tons. The Engineer's Estimate for the supply and delivery is \$6.8 million.

Plans, Specifications, Instructions to Proposers, and Forms of Proposal and Contract are on file at the office of the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority, One Maritime Plaza, Toledo, OH 43604 and may be obtained during normal business hours. The plans will also be on file in the plan room of McGraw-Hill Construction-F.W. Dodge.

Proposals must be submitted on the form included in the Specifications and shall be accompanied by a certified check or an acceptable Proposal Bond with satisfactory surety specifying the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority as the obligee, in the sum of not less than ten percent (10%) of the total proposal amount.

Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

The successful bidder will be required to submit a Contract Bond, Maintenance Bond, and Certificate of Insurance.

The lowest responsive and responsible bid shall be determined in accordance with the Port Authority's Resolution No. 68-00 as found in the General Conditions.

The Port Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any technicalities as it may deem best for their interest. The Port Authority also reserves the right to add or subtract from quantities shown in the proposal.
